Safety, Behavior and Rules of Conduct Guidelines.

- All adult guides, leaders, and chaperones must have background checks and clearances.
- Only approved adult guides, leaders, and chaperones will be a part of the Youth to Yellowstone Group at any time.
- **<u>Guides</u>** will set the itinerary within the PARK while considering the input of leaders and chaperones.
- <u>Leaders</u> are responsible for the **discipline** and **safety** of all students. Extra activities are the decisions of leaders and guides with input from the chaperones.
- <u>Chaperones</u> are primarily responsible for driving, but they are expected to step in as needed to ensure student safety or to correct bad choices made by students. Discipline is the responsibility of the leaders and guides.
- Students **CANNOT** use drugs, alcohol, tobacco or profanity and they must obey safety rules and **ALL** park rules. Leaders, guides and chaperones are due respect and shall be treated with respect at all times.
- Men, women, boys, and girls will be assigned to segregated tents.
